Finalists: Each finalist will participate in a personal interview on April 7th or April 14th, so please plan accordingly.* Each finalist will be required to present either a mini-showing of his/her work or a performance. Grant recipients will be required to participate in a formal awards ceremony on **June 10, 2018**. Participants may be videotaped, with parent/guardian written permission, first during the personal interview and presentation and/or later during the awards ceremony. *Please be advised that the above interview dates have been pre-arranged, but could be subject to change due to circumstances beyond our control.

MLKCCSD PURPOSE: We are a nonprofit charitable organization. The MLKCCSD established the Visual & Performing Arts Educational Grants to support graduating high school seniors who will be majoring (at an accredited college, university or conservatory) in the areas of visual and performing arts. These grants are available to all San Diego County high school seniors, who are U. S. citizens, regardless of race, ethnicity, religion or sex. Our educational grants have been designed to assist students of exceptional talent, especially those who demonstrate a financial need. **Each educational grant typically ranges from \$1,500 to \$3,500.** Multiple grants are awarded each year.
